FY2007 Coordinated Monitoring Schedule

Wright showed the group (via the internet) the statewide coordinated monitoring schedule and took the group on a "tour" of website hosted by the Lower Colorado River Authority. The site contains all water quality monitoring stations in the State of Texas. Wright showed the group how to query the schedule to get any information they might be interested in. 2006 Basin Summary Report

Running took the group step by step through the 2006 Basin Summary Report to show the features and interactivity of the report on CD. Running explained that due to the size of the report (over 500 printed pages) that it was cost prohibitive to print hardcopy report s but that an interactive CD version is much more economical. The group spent about 30 minutes going through the report. Attendees gave feedback and comments as they went trough the different sections. Running also showed the group the value of the Search function. The CD is 100% searchable which allows the user to look up information on specific streams or pollutants very easily.
