Current Situation

- 1. Add two projects from the 2016-2017 UPWP and corresponding budget amounts to the 2018-2019 UPWP.
- 2. Increase budgets for two existing projects.

Action Requested

The Technical Advisory Committee recommended TPC approval of this amendment at its October 18, 2017 meeting. Staff requests approval of UPWP Resolution No. 18/19 UPWP-2.

TASK II CHANGES

Project Additions:

The following projects were present in the 2016-2017 UPWP and anticipated to finish prior to FY 2018. Work on these projects has continued into FY 2018, which requires their addition to the 2018-2019 UPWP.

- 1. Subtask 2.2 Physical Features, Data & Modeling Support The following project is added to Subtask 2.2a, which increases the FY 2018 subtask budget by \$20,000 in TPF funds:
 - A consultant will be utilized to determine the method, cost and design for collecting household origin and destination data. These data will be used for updating the regional travel demand model (TPF).
- **2. Subtask 2.2 Physical Features, Data & Modeling Support** The following project is added to Subtask 2.2a, which increases the FY 2018 subtask budget by \$90,000 in TPF funds:
 - A consultant will be utilized to conduct onboard origin-destination survey for transit services operated by regional transit providers (TPF).

Budget Increases:

- 1. Subtask 2.2 Physical Features, Data & Modeling Support The following project budget for Subtask 2.2a is increased \$48,000 in TPF funds for FY 2018, and \$32,000 in TPF funds for FY 2019:
 - Develop and support a regional traffic data viewer.
- **2. Subtask 2.2 Physical Features, Data & Modeling Support** The following project budget for Subtask 2.2b is increased \$45,000 in TPF funds for FY 2018:
 - A consultant will be utilized to assist with the continued development of a Cube Cargo based tour truck model (TPF).
