Houston MSA OTM Total Nonfarm Change May 2020






Largest one-month gain on record Implies 1 in 5 of 350k jobs lost Mar-April recovered




Houston MSA Sectors Adding Most Jobs OTM and Implied Recovery Rate May 2020






Houston MSA Sectors Losing Most Jobs OTM and Cumulative Percent Loss March - May 2020

Houston Metro Unemployment Rate






Houston MSA Unemployment Rates & Unemployed Persons (NSA) February – May 2020





Houston MSA Unemployment Rate (NSA) May 1990-2020









13-County Gulf Coast Region Unemployment Rates May 2020



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
13-County Gulf Coast Cities Unemployment Rates May 2020







13-County Gulf Coast Region <u>Daily</u> Active Job Ads March 1st - July 6th 2019 vs. 2020



^{*}Note: due to a mass expiration of job ads at the end May a steep drop in total ads was observed. This phenomenon was first documented in the 6/7 update of this report and has failed to reverse since that time suggesting it remains a significant event. Note that impacts on 7-day over 7-day trends are no longer a concern however the event now falls within 30-day over 30-day trends and as a result trends within this timeframe should be viewed with caution.
