

RAQPC Membership Information

RAQPC Bylaws: Article 3: Section 1-9

1. The Committee will consist of up to 26 members.
2. The Committee will be broadly representative of those within the H-GAC region affected by air quality issues including representatives of transportation agencies, local government, public health and pollution control agencies, industry and employers, and citizen and environmental groups.
4. The Committee will be appointed by the Board of Directors from nominations by individual Board members and interested organizations.
6. Member terms begin at the first meeting after June 30 of each year and last for two years, or until a successor is appointed.
9. The Committee will have staggered terms of the members, one half to be appointed one year and the other half to be appointed the following year.

Discussion

The RAQPC Membership is divided into three divisions:

- Business and Industries
- Citizens and Environmental Organizations
- Local Governments

The practice of creating a Membership that has 13 Membership terms expiring on “Even” years, and 13 Membership terms expiring on “Odd” years have not been strictly followed due to past midterm replacements. This cycle moves RAQPC closer to Article 3: Section 9 in the by-laws.

Members need to be current, as officers will be elected in May to assume duties in the June meeting.

Summary

Each member whose term is expiring in 2010 is in good standing and is active in RAQPC. H-GAC Staff has requested the sponsoring bodies to “re-nominate” all RAQPC members whose terms are expiring in 2010. Sponsoring Bodies will make nominations, which will be approved by the H-GAC Board of Directors.
