

Houston Air Quality Report

- Thus far in calendar year 2007, the Houston/Galveston area has experienced **thirteen** days in exceedence of the eight hour standard and **five** days in exceedence of the one hour standard. The highest eight hour average concentration (112 ppb) occurred on May 15, 2007 at the Crosby Library monitor. The highest one hour reading (166 ppb) was on May 14, 2007 at the LaPorte Sylvan Beach monitor.
- On June 15, 2007, Governor Perry submitted a letter to the EPA administrator requesting the HGB area be reclassified from *moderate* to *severe* nonattainment.
- The South Coast AQMD (Los Angeles area) has recorded **27** eight hour exceedence days thus far in 2007.
- On June 12, 2007, the California Air Resources Board voted to make a formal request to the EPA to reclassify the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District as *extreme* nonattainment.
