## **Major Changes to the 2025 Regional Transportation Plan**

**February 2005**

### **Text of the 2025 RTP**

In June 2004, the Transportation Policy Council (TPC) adopted the Draft 2025 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP). The RTP has been revised and reorganized, spurred in part by public comment, the text has been restructured for greater comprehension and cohesion. The RTP now has an executive summary and a summary for each appendix, within the main body of the document. The result of these changes is that the reader can quickly gain an oversight of both the RTP's main policies for managing the region's mobility as well as a sample of the specific projects and programs for achieving these aims. The RTP has also received many substantive corrections and changes based on information gained from public comment, new modeling runs and other newly calculated values. Maps, charts, statistics, details or other information have been reviewed and, where appropriate, made current.

The revised Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) represents a detailed version of the first three years of the RTP and contains a list of projects that have been approved for funding. The principal changes to the TIP involve the contingency list. Some projects included in the TIP have been changed including adjustments to estimated let dates reflecting project timeframes, slight adjustments to scopes of work, and in some cases, project costs have been revised. These changes occurred as part of the normal TIP submittal and selection process.

Projects that do not affect air quality conformity were added to the plan as part of the submittal process. Such projects included access management improvements, transit improvements, Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS), and bicycle improvements.

### **Appendixes**

The appendixes have been reorganized. What were formerly eighteen separate documents now have been combined into five thematically-based appendixes. The purpose of this reorganization is to group similar topics together so that the reader can find all topics related to a particular theme. They are: Analysis, Recommendations, Special Topics, Setting Regional Priorities, and Air Quality Conformity. The chapters are the former, individual appendixes. The tables below list the appendixes in their old and new orders.

Most appendixes have been rewritten, added to, combined, condensed or otherwise made current. Some have undergone substantial revision due in part to the new organizational framework. For example, former Appendixes J (Regional Transit Plan) and M (2025 Needs Assessment and System Evaluation) have been rewritten so that a description of the entire network as it exists today (roadway and transit) is described in Appendix A, Chapter 2: System Evaluation, while all transportation needs (roadway and transit) can be found in Appendix B, Chapter 1: Regional Transportation Needs Assessment.

Appendix A, Chapter 6 Travel Forecasting Procedures is a new addition. This appendix describes the types of information used in the transportation modeling process.

Some chapters still contain references to appendixes in the old naming and numbering scheme. The list below shows the appendixes with their new names and numbers, and the chart on the following page provides a cross-reference between the new and old schemes.
