


Yearly Change in Employment for Select NAICS Industries in Houston-Sugar Land-Baytown MSA Feb 2020 - Feb 2021


Monthly Change in Employment for Select NAICS Industries in Houston-Sugar Land-Baytown MSA Jan - Feb 2021

Houston CMSA Single Family Permits





Houston CMSA Multi-family Permits




