About the Temporary Pedestrian/Bicycle Counters

The Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) has temporary counters (TRAFx Infrared Trail Counters: Generation III) that can be borrowed by local governments and transportation agencies to count the number of people using off-street pedestrian and bicycle facilities. Infrared technology is used to count the number of people passing the counter. The counters do not differentiate between pedestrians and bicyclists, but count the total number of users.

The Texas Transportation Institute (TTI) owns additional temporary counters that it deploys along off-street pedestrian and bicycle facilities statewide.

Overall Trends and Notes

- Higher Weekend Usage At all locations, average daily usage was higher during weekends than on weekdays.
- Evenings Busiest on Weekdays On weekdays, usage peaked in the evening at all locations. Peak usage during weekends was more variable.
- Rain Impacts Usage Rain seems to impact usage. At all locations, days with significant rainfall (Monday, February 22 and Tuesday, February 23) had the least usage.
- Increased Usage Since October 2014

At some locations, this is the second time temporary pedestrian/bicycle counters were deployed. In October 2014, the counters were successfully deployed at Buffalo Bayou North Bank: St. Thomas High School (Counter #2) and Buffalo Bayou South Bank: Eleanor Tinsley Park (Counter E) (A counter was also deployed at Buffalo Bayou North Bank: Police Memorial in October 2014, but it malfunctioned and did not collect data). Average daily usage was higher in February 2016 than it was in October 2014.

- Average daily usage at Counter #2 (Buffalo Bayou North Bank: St. Thomas High School) was 29.5% higher than what was recorded in October 2014 (768 users/day in February 2016 vs. 593 users/day in October 2014).
- Average daily usage at Counter E (Buffalo Bayou South Bank: Eleanor Tinsley Park) was 118.8% higher than what was recorded in October 2014 (1,569 users/day in February 2016 vs. 717 users/day in October 2014). Note that major events were held near this location during both deployment periods.
- Events along Allen Parkway

Events along Allen Parkway may have impacted usage. For example, Allen Parkway was closed for events (ConocoPhillips Rodeo Run and Rodeo Parade) on Saturday, February 27; usage at Counter E (Buffalo Bayou South Bank: Eleanor Tinsley Park), which was placed immediately adjacent to Allen Parkway, was particularly high that day.

- Counter Vandalized/Stolen
 Counter F (Buffalo Bayou South Bank: Sesquicentennial Park) was vandalized and stolen during the deployment period, so no data was retrieved.
- Maximum Capacity Reached

Three counters reached maximum storage capacity (approximately 14,000 counts) and stopped collecting data prior to the end of the deployment period.

- Counter A (Buffalo Bayou North Bank: Green Tree Nature Area) reached maximum storage capacity and stopped collecting data on Sunday, February 28, 2016 at approximately 6:00 p.m.
- Counter B (Buffalo Bayou North Bank: Police Memorial) reached maximum storage capacity and stopped collecting data on Saturday, February 27, 2016 at approximately 2:15 p.m.
- Counter E (Buffalo Bayou South Bank: Eleanor Tinsley Park) reached maximum storage capacity and stopped collecting data on Saturday, February 27, 2016 at approximately 7:15 p.m.
- Allen Parkway Reconstruction

During the deployment period, Allen Parkway was under construction and in the process of being reconfigured.

Comparing Usage along Shared-Use Paths to Parallel Pedestrian Pathways

A shared-use path runs along each bank of Buffalo Bayou between Shepherd Drive and Interstate 45. At some locations, pathways exclusively for pedestrians parallel the main shared-use paths. To compare usage of these different facilities, temporary pedestrian/bicycle counters were placed on shared-use paths and pedestrian pathways near each other to create a *screen line*.

During the deployment period, 10,947 pedestrians and cyclists used either the pedestrians-only pathway next to Memorial Drive or the main shared-use path near St. Thomas High School, on the north bank of Buffalo Bayou east of Shepherd Drive. 84.1% of pedestrians and cyclists used the main shared-use path, and only 15.9% used the pedestrians-only pathway.

During the deployment period, 27,714 pedestrians and cyclists passed Johnny Steele Dog Park on either the pedestrians-only pathway adjacent to Buffalo Bayou, the main shared-use path, or the shared-use path adjacent to Allen Parkway. About 37.9% of pedestrian/bicycle traffic used the pedestrians-only pathway, while 37.6% used the main shared-use path. Only 24.5% of pedestrians and cyclists passing through the area used the shared-use path adjacent to Allen Parkway.

Counter A (Buffalo Bayou North Bank: Green Tree Natural Area) was located on the opposite side of Buffalo Bayou, across from the Johnny Steele Dog Park. Counter A reached maximum storage capacity (approximately 14,000 counts) and stopped collecting data prior to the end of the deployment period (Sunday, February 28, 2016 at approximately 6:00 p.m.).

During the deployment period, 18,324 pedestrians and cyclists passed the Nature Play Area using one of three facilities: the main shared-use path, the pedestrians-only pathway adjacent to Buffalo Bayou, or the shared-use path that passes between the Lee and Joe Jamail Skatepark and the Nature Play Area. 31.5% of pedestrian/bicycle traffic through the

area was along the main shared-use path, while 25.3% was along the pedestrians-only pathway. 43.2% of pedestrian/bicycle traffic in the area was along the shared-use path that provides access to Sabine Street.

Counter E (Buffalo Bayou South Bank: Eleanor Tinsley Park) was located on the opposite side of Buffalo Bayou, across from the Nature Play Area. Counter E reached maximum storage capacity (approximately 14,000 counts) and stopped collecting data prior to the end of the deployment period (Saturday, February 27, 2016 at approximately 7:15 p.m.).



<image>


1: Pedestrian Pathway Adjacent to Memorial Drive Facing East

Image 2: Pedestrian Pathway Adjacent to Memorial Drive Facing West




Image 6: Buffalo Bayou Trail near Lost Lake Facing West

Image 12: Shared-Use Path Adjacent to Allen Parkway



Image 15: Buffalo Bayou Trail near Police Memorial Facing East




Image 16: Buffalo Bayou Trail near Police Memorial Facing West








Image 17: Buffalo Bayou Trail near Nature Play Area Facing East




Image 18: Buffalo Bayou Trail near Nature Play Area Facing West








Image 19: Pedestrian Pathway near Nature Play Area Facing East










Image 21: Connection to Sabine Street Facing East




Image 22: Connection to Sabine Street Facing West








Image 23: Shared-Use Path near Eleanor Tinsley Park Facing East (Photo from Previous Deployment)




Image 24: Shared-Use Path near Eleanor Tinsley Park Facing West (Photo from Previous Deployment)






