Chairman David Robinson recognized Ms. Lucinda Martinez, H-GAC, for the Certification of the Quorum and she conducted the Roll Call of the TPC membership. Fourteen (14) members comprise a quorum. # ITEM 6. AMENDMENTS TO THE 2023-2026 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) AND THE 2045 REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN (RTP), MR. JIM DICKINSON, H-GAC

Mr. Jim Dickinson, H-GAC, provided a presentation on the Amendments to the 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and the 2045 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP). A summary of the proposed revisions to the 2023-2026 TIP and 2045 RTP are included below:

- Delay the City of Tomball's Category-2 (Metropolitan Mobility) funded FM 2920 reconstruction project (MPOID 17085) from FY 2026 to FY 2027 and increase its funding to \$30.1M to reflect the approved FY 2024 TxDOT Unified Transportation Program. (+\$1.5M; Total Cost: \$30.1M)
- Reduce the Transportation Alternative Set Aside (TASA) funding of the City of Conroe's FY 2024
  Montgomery Bike Loop construction project (MPO ID 17121), which is in TxDOT's Statewide Bike and
  Pedestrian Statewide Program (SCSJ 5000-00-916), in accordance with updated design estimates. (\$2.6M; Total Cost: \$4.2M)
- Add the Houston-Galveston Area Council's Livable Centers Studies Cycle-7 project (MPO ID 18961) to FY 2024 of TxDOT's Statewide Preliminary Engineering Statewide Program (SCSJ 5000-00-950) with \$2.4M of Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) funds which will be matched with 475K Transportation Development Credits (TDCs). (+\$2.4M; Total Cost: \$2.4M)

#### ITEM 7. TPC TIP PROCESS REVIEW COMMITTEE, CRAIG RABORN, H-GAC

Chairman Robinson gave the Council a brief overview on the purpose and goals of TPC TIP Process Review Committee. The TPC TIP Process Review Committee is not intended to disrupt the process but to facilitate project flow and funding and operate as an observant body. Chairman Robinson proceeded to introduce Craig Raborn, H-GAC, to continue the presentation. Mr. Raborn informed the Council the TPC Prioritization Work Group provided guidance identifying goals, priorities, and policies for our Project Selection Activities. The Prioritization Workgroup developed the Project Selections Process to implement TPC's guidance while selecting new projects for TIP and 10-year plan which is currently underway. Mr. Raborn gave the Council an overview of the workgroup tasks, the composition of original Project Prioritizations Workgroup, the remaining or continuing active TPC or TAC members and the expected commitment, and next steps.

Mr. Raborn requested TPC approval to authorize the TPC Chair to appoint a Workgroup to monitor the TIP project selection process and report back to the TPC after the process is concluded. Chairman Robinson requested a motion from the Council. A motion was made by Judge Mark Keough and seconded by Mayor Kevin Cole. Chairman Robinson called for discussion. A question-and-answer and comment period occurred after the presentation. The Council voted and approved the appointment of the TPC TIP Process Review Committee.

#### ITEM 8. CARRY-OVER BALANCE SPEND-DOWN/PROJECT SELECTION PROCESS UPDATE, CALLIE BARNES

Ms. Callie Barnes, H-GAC, informed the Council that 230 Readiness Questionnaires were sent to Project Sponsors. 188 Questionnaires were completed. Some projects were withdrawn due to developments. H-GAC will inform local sponsors of estimated let date. Ms. Barnes gave an overview of the Carry-Over Balance Spend-Down Projects timeline. A brief question-and-answer period occurred after the presentation. Ms. Barnes gave the Council an update of the status of the Project Selection Process. 88 projects were submitted by sponsors to be analyzed in the Regional Goods Movement Investment category. 40 projects scored to go to the next phase of assessment with a Project scoring greater than 50. 2 projects were withdrawn from consideration. A Benefit Cost Analysis was requested for 38 projects. Ms. Barnes concluded her presentation by giving the Council an overview of the next steps. A question-and-answer period occurred after the presentation.

and mobile app bridging Transportation Systems Management and Operations, Mobility as a Service, Travel Demand Management and Behavioral Economics and is powered by live data from local transportation authorities to provide users the most accurate travel information available. Ms. Bustillos also informed the Council the ConnectSmart Program is a nationally recognized program and described activities to promote the app. A comment period occurred after the presentation.
