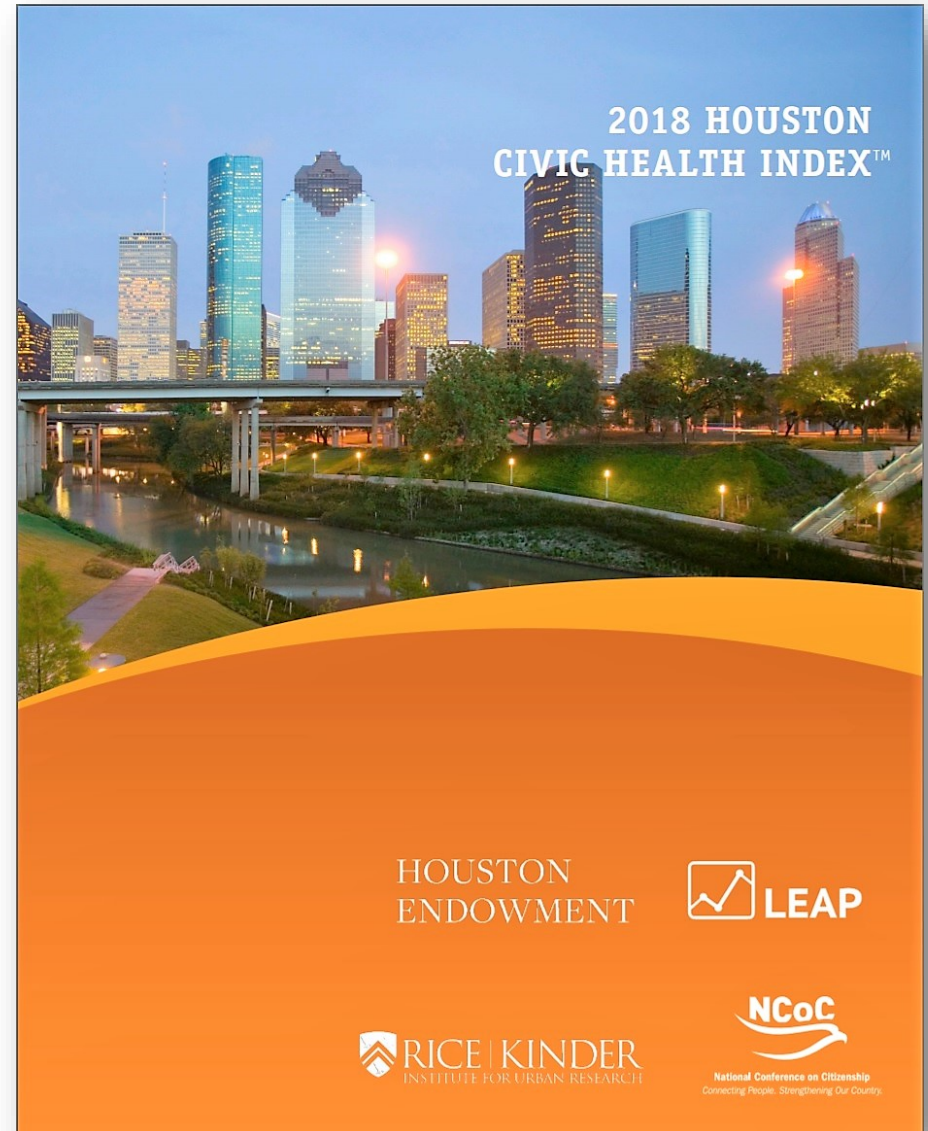
# Collaborative and Data Driven Planning Process
