SB 102	Introduced	TERP	Relating to allocation of certain money in the Texas emissions reduction plan fund to air quality monitoring activities.	1) Adds and funds monitoring requirements. 2) Sets aside 5% for clean fleet program. 3) Entire bill may be underfunded due to overall funding shortfall.
HB 571 / SB 160	Introduced	Aggregates	Relating to the regulation of certain aggregate production operations by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality; providing penalties.	1) Require responsible parties to register with TCEQ before extracting aggregates. 2) Require site visit by the TCEQ. 3) Grant TCEQ the authority to assign fees and penalties.
HB 51	Introduced	Energy Efficiency Standards	Relating to energy efficiency standards for certain buildings and to high-performance design, construction, and renovation standards for certain government buildings and facilities.	1) Requires the State to meet new Energy Efficiency Standards when constructing or renovating "Certain" buildings. 2) Focuses on both energy and water conservation. 3) Applies to "Instructional facilities".
