Please find enclosed with this letter a copy of Resolution 2008-10. The resolution was passed by the Dayton City Council on Monday, June 16<sup>th</sup>, 2008. The resolution re-affirms the City of Dayton's support for the Projects included in the Regional Transportation Coordination Summary produced by HGAC and dated May 2008. Specifically the Council expressed their strong support for the construction of a Regional Transfer and Park and Ride Facility in Dayton.

We have been tracking this project closely for the past several years. We have participated in the regional planning process that took place in 2007 and have supported the Brazos Transit District's efforts to acquire funding for operations of the facility. We have even offered to provide a temporary location to get the service up and running as soon as possible.

## RESOLUTION NO. 2008-10

**A Resolution By The City Council Of Dayton, Texas; Said Resolution stating support for the Liberty County Transit Plan and the establishment of a Liberty County Park & Ride facility in Dayton.**

**WHEREAS**, the demand for transportation solutions has continued to grow; and

**WHEREAS**, the need for a park and ride facility in Dayton was initially identified by Brazos Transit District and the City of Dayton several years ago; and

**WHEREAS**, the Liberty County Regional Public Transportation Coordination Summary produced by HGAC in May 2008 includes the Regional Transfer Facility and Park and Ride Facility in Dayton; and

**WHEREAS**, construction funds have been programmed for FY2009 in the HGAC Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Dayton plays an active role in transportation and transit related projects, and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council is willing to provide a temporary park and ride location until the facility is constructed.

**NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved** by the City Council of Dayton, Texas that:

The City Council does herein indicate its full and complete support for the Projects included in the Regional Public Transportation Coordination Summary produced by HGAC and dated May 2008.

The City Council does herein indicate its full and complete support for the Brazos Transit Districts efforts to obtain operational funding for the Park and Ride Facility

The City Council does herein call for the regional park and ride facility in Dayton to be constructed as soon as possible.

The City Council authorizes the Mayor to forward a copy of this resolution to HGAC and TXDOT along with a letter more fully expressing the City's support for this project.
