Item 1 – Subcommittee Roll Call

The meeting started with a roll call to determine the members and/or alternatives present.

Item 3 - Cost Overrun Policy (Adam Beckom)

Adam Beckom noted that the subject of cost overruns had been discussed extensively by the TIP Subcommittee. Comments raised by subcommittee members have been incorporated in the policy abstract. Staff anticipate that the cost overrun policy will be taken to the TAC and the TPC for action during the month of October 2022.

Cost overrun requests are broadly described as **Foreseeable Overruns** (e.g. overruns due to changes in project scope or schedule delays), and **Unforeseeable Overruns** (e.g. overruns resulting from higher unit costs/increased right of way costs because of the ongoing market-wide inflationary pressure or because of unexpected policy changes such as revisions to federal design standards). A 50/50 federal/local funding split is recommended for the foreseeable overruns while an 80/20 split is recommended for overruns deemed unforeseeable.

Partners who anticipate cost overruns are advised to notify staff as early as nine (9) months prior to the anticipated time federal funds are needed.

<u>Issues to Consider:</u>

How to treat/characterize cost overruns associated with policy changes by the local railroads or utility companies.

Item 4 – Project Selection Process Update (Vishu Lingala)

Vishu Lingala briefed the subcommittee on the meeting staff and a few TIP subcommittee members held with the TPC Workgroup on September 26, 2022. The main goals of the meeting were to update the workgroup on recent subcommittee activities and to seek guidance on the novel directions being considered for the 2026 TIP selection process. A follow-up meeting is being planned to complete the deliberations.

The meeting agenda included:

- Review of the TPC Guidance
- Update on TIP Subcommittee Activities
- Statement of Project Interests Summary
- Core Project Selection Issues
 - o Multiple selection cycles v. one combined selection process
 - o Relative weighting of TPC goals and priorities
- Next Steps/Adjournment

During the meeting with the workgroup, some time was spent going over certain issues that the TIP subcommittee had failed to resolve such as the urban/rural funding set-aside program, potential revisions to the project selection process, as well as the options being considered to address the

carryover balances. Response by the TPC Workgroup while generally supportive, was accompanied by a sense of urgency to reach a resolution on the project selection process. Positive comments raised by the workgroup members suggested they were intrigued by the multiple selection cycle approach. It is now up to staff and TIP subcommittee members to develop a workable framework for implementing this strategy which the TPC workgroup may evaluate.
