# RESOLUTION FOR APPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS TO THE 2014-2015 UNIFIED PLANNING WORK PROGRAM

#### **Background**

The 2014-2015 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) describes the transportation plans and related air quality planning activities that will be undertaken in the region during fiscal years 2014 and 2015 (October 1, 2013 – September 30, 2015). Through the development of the UPWP, changes in regional transportation planning priorities are identified. The current 2014-2015 UPWP was initially adopted by the Transportation Policy Council (TPC) on July 26, 2013, and amended it on December 20, 2013, March 28, 2014, and April 25, 2014.

## **Current Situation**

This set of amendments proposes to do the following:

- 1. Remove reference to transportation coordination outside Harris County per FHWA comment;
- 2. Identify funding for the Montgomery County Thoroughfare Plan;
- 3. Identify funding for the City of Houston's Bicycle Master Plan
- 4. Remove the Freight Wayfinding product per the May 2014 TIP Amendment;
- 5. Increase funding for the Port Connector and SH 36A Studies per the May 2014 TIP Amendment.
- 6. Increase Transportation Planning Funds (TPF) carryover from \$5,244,414 to \$5,796,300; and
- 7. Increase Transportation Planning Funds (TPF) received from \$16,006,806 to \$\$17,398,516;

In addition, a set of annual certifications, including debarment certification, lobbying, and adherence to contracting and procurement procedures, have been included for signature.

#### **Action Requested**

Staff requests TPC approval of the amendments to the 2014-2015 Unified Planning Work Program.

WHEREAS, the Transportation Policy Council adopted the 2014-2015 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) on July 26, 2013 and amended it on December 20, 2013, March 28, 2014, and April 25, 2014; and

WHEREAS, in Task 3, Short Range Planning, reference to transportation coordination outside Harris County has been removed per FHWA comment; and

WHEREAS, in Task 4, Long Range Planning, \$300,000 is programmed for a thoroughfare plan for Montgomery County and \$125,000 is programmed for the City of Houston's Bicycle Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, in Task 5, Special Planning Studies, the Wayfinding product has been reprogrammed for development of the Port Connector/IH 69 Relief Route and SH 36A Studies; and

WHEREAS, the MPO has received an additional \$1,391,710 in Transportation Planning Funds, as well as an additional \$551,886 in carryover funding from FY 12-13; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRANSPORTATION POLICY COUNCIL, THAT REVISIONS TO THE 2014-2015 UNIFIED PLANNING WORK PROGRAM, AS SHOWN IN THE ATTACHMENT, ARE HEREBY APPROVED AND INCORPORATED INTO THE 2014-2015 UNIFIED PLANNING WORK PROGRAM.

- An additional \$1,391,710 of Transportation Planning Funds (FHWA PL-112 and FTA 5303) has been allocated by TxDOT to H-GAC, increasing Transportation Planning Funds to \$17,398,516
- An additional \$551,886 in FHWA PL-112 funds from the 2012-13 UPWP has been identified, increasing total carryover to \$5,796,300, and increasing total Transportation Planning Funds available to \$23,194,816
- Total under-programmed TPF funds have been increased by \$1,693,596 to \$3,552,893
