### **ITS Architecture/Systems Engineering Scope**

- Charlie and Tony went over the revised scope of services for the Enhanced TSM&O Clearinghouse concept. Key issues include:
  - Development of a living web-based ITS Architecture that could be downloaded for individual projects
  - Regular quarterly updates will be a regular item for Operations Task Force meetings
  - Build off of the Capability Maturity Model process from FHWA for the region
  - Develop Systems Engineering Evaluation Process
  - Conduct a communication inventory
  - o Charlie passed out a set of needed information from agencies about their systems
- Operations Task Force meetings will be the discussion group to address any proposed amendments to the ITS Architecture.
- Predominant focus of the ITS Architecture will involve more mature and common systems.

## **ITS/Operation Projects Planning Factors**

- We need to reword the triple-negative item -
- We may wish to address the requirement of having a budget for systems engineering for highrisk projects
  - o Is there budget available for high-risk systems engineering if required?
  - There should be some determination of high-risk/low-risk involved
- Under Asset Management Item should be changed to "Demonstrate past five years of maintenance budget and spending for past ITS projects"
- Planning factors should otherwise stay the same.
- Continue TOPS B/C for project analysis.
