Background



- Voluntary EPA and Local Government Collaboration
- Program Goals:
 - Reduce emissions for public health protection
 - Position areas to remain in attainment
 - Direct available resources toward actions that address developing issues
- Participants must submit an annual progress report



Requirements



- Must develop and submit annual Path Forward report which includes:
 - Background and status of PM2.5 within the region
 - Overview of voluntary actions undertaken by stakeholders
 - Qualitatively describes these measures
 - Discusses the implementation of each measure
 - Provides quantitative results if possible



Participation Timeline



- June 2013: H-GAC requests to join the program
- 2014: An initial Path Forward report was drafted and approved by RAQPAC and stakeholders
- 2015 through 2021: Follow-on Path Forward reports drafted and approved by RAQPAC
- 2022: Ninth Path Forward report drafted
