HARRIS County Data Profile



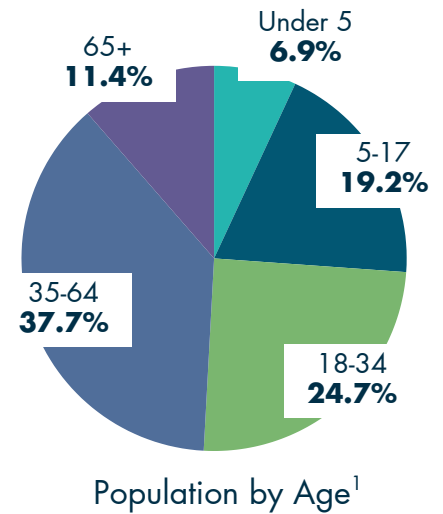

MATAGORDA County Data Profile



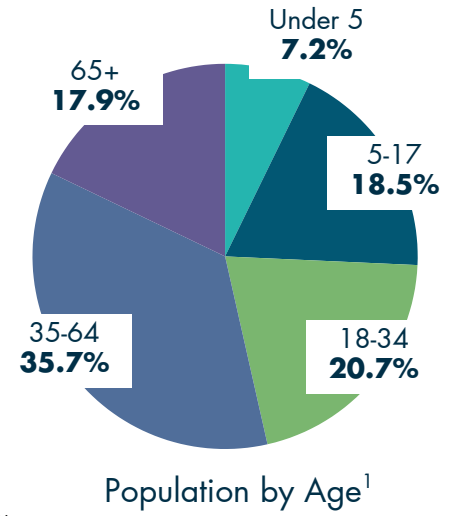

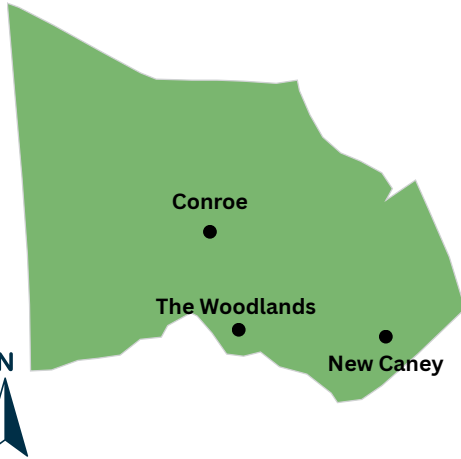

MONTGOMERY County Data Profile



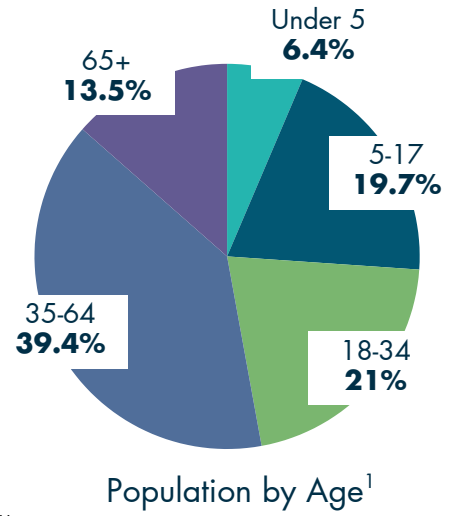

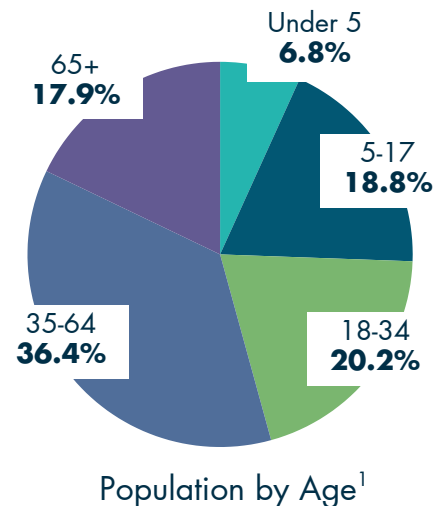
