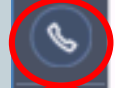
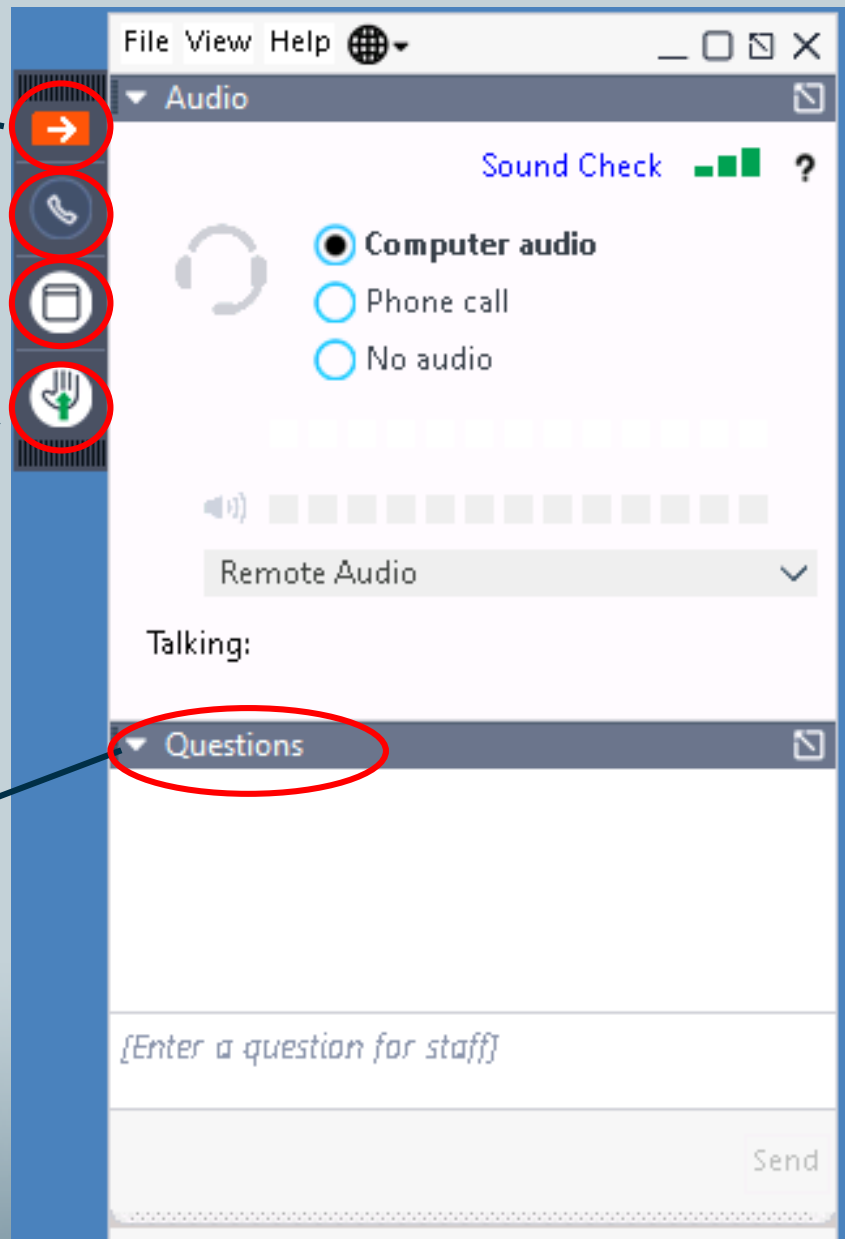

PNA Awards and Recognition

- Approved in March –
Addition of “Project Value”
 - This will help us better track the value of the investments to our region through parks and natural areas
 - These will not count toward judging but may help to make sure the award is in the right category

PNA Awards and Recognition

- Add scorable “Resiliency” Question
 - Describe how the project improves/will improve resiliency and sustainability of the area
 - How do we want to score this?
 - Scoring Structure - Take points from other questions to keep the total at 100
 - Bonus Points- Make the total over 100

What are the project objectives?	3
How did the project meet these objectives?	6
Describe cost-benefit and funding solutions for the project.	3
Describe how the project preserves/will preserve, restores/will restore and/or improves/will improve the quality of life for the area and users.	15
Describe how the project created/will create, preserved/ will preserve, restored/ will restore and/or expanded/will expand natural areas and ecosystems.	15
Describe how the project preserves/will preserve, restores/will restore and/or improves/will improve quality of nearby water bodies.	15
Describe how the project created/will create, expanded/will expand and/or improved/will improve park areas.	15
Describe how the project improves/will improve the resiliency and sustainability for the area.	0
Describe how the project can be a model for similar initiatives in the region?	10
Does the project include the reclamation, reuse or repurposing of land? If so, please explain.	3
Does the project include land acquisition, particularly in underserved areas or in areas with future needs? If so, please explain.	3
Describe how the project involves/will involve a collaborative effort between public, political jurisdictions and/or private businesses.	3
Does the project address specific public health benefits? If so, please explain.	3
Describe public involvement and/or input related to the project.	3
Describe how the project meets the needs of the community.	3
