Project Scope

2020-2021 PERFECT TRAIL PROJECT



Trailhead

Typically located at trail entry point and/or parking area. Key elements should include map, orientation, rules, expectation, amenity menu, and site features.



Map

An effective map should be attractive, easy to read and understand. It should have detailed, relevant information and be orientated properly based upon its exact location.



Wayfinding

Communicates the current trail the user is on and clearly identifies the options - left, right, and straight ahead. The amount of information should be limited, relevant and include arrows.



Park namesake

Although not necessary or appropriate in all situations, this interpretive sign is often very welcomed. Parks are often named for people with users having little or no knowledge of who or why.



Interpretive signs

All places have an inherent story. Parks often traverse through historic or nature settings. Interpretive signs provide a education element making for a more complete user experience.



911/mile marker

Typically these are printed on highly reflective highway film and placed at 1/4 mile increments. Implementation of a specific letter and number system can allow authorities to locate users quickly and easily.




