1. Call to Order and Roll Call

2. Certify Quorum

A quorum of 12 is required to conduct committee business. A total of 21 members were represented by either themself or their alternate.

3. Action: Vote on Use of Remaining FY24/25 Solid Waste Funds (passed)

Erin Livingston, H-GAC, led a discussion of staff recommendations for use of the remaining solid waste funds from FY24/25. The proposed order of spending was the following:

- 1. Original grantee spend the money
- 2. H-GAC spend the money on debris trainings and resource development
- 3. A different grantee spend the money
- 4. H-GAC spend the money on other items such as HHW training, online ads, update to an old study/publication, etc.

A motion was made by Debbie Elliott, Chambers County, and seconded by Cheryl Burton-Fentress, Harris County, to proceed spending grant funds in the order outlined by staff. The motion passed.

4. Action: FY26/27 Solid Waste Grant Program (passed)

Erin Livingston, H-GAC, led the discussion on the FY26/27 Solid Waste Grant Program, including the grant application and the proposed timeline for the next grant cycle. Ms. Livingston explained that the full budget for H-GAC's Solid Waste Management Program has not yet been decided by the Texas Association of Regional Councils. The grant program proposal included the following items:

- Keep all categories of projects eligible
- No minimum or maximum grant amount
- Grant funding to be available between \$950,000 and \$1.05 million
- Grant application to open on September 2 and close on October 14
- No changes to the scoring criteria

A motion was made by Terry Woodson, Frontier Waste Solutions, and seconded by Commissioner Chip Reed, Austin County, to proceed with the proposed plan for the next grant cycle outlined by H-GAC staff. The motion passed.
