Fitness Classes:

TABATA

A type of HIIT-one subsection under the broad umbrella of high-intensity interval training. Specifically, it's a four-minute workout consisting of eight rounds of 20 seconds of work at maximum effort, followed by 10 seconds of rest. For 13+ years.

INTERVAL TRAINING

Come build strength and stamina from a combination of cardio, strength and bodyweight workouts. For 13+ years.

LINE DANCING

Exercise by dancing to lively, upbeat music. This is a fun way to socially dance, no partner necessary. For 13+ years.

CARDIO & STRENGTH TRAINING

A mix of both cardio and strength workouts to power your morning routine. For 13+ years.

YOGA

Targeted Neighborhood Clean-Up:

We will be partnering up with Waste Connections for Angleton residents to dispose of heavy and bulky trash items. Green Thumb Gardening Workshops:

Facilitate a 2020 gardening series promoting best practices in home garden development and management. The programs will be instructed by Brazoria County AgriLife Horticulture Agent, Stephen Brueggerhoff and Brazoria County Master Gardener experts. Topics will include vegetable production as well as selected home landscape development topics. Detailed flyers for the topic covered each month will be provided at the Angleton Recreation Center as well as online.

Angleton Business Beautification Incentive Project:

The Angleton Keep Angleton Beautiful board announces the Angleton Business Beautification Incentive Project. This is for the purpose of enhancing existing business landscaping improvements including flowers, flower pots, potted bushes, other vegetation, etc. The Angleton Business Beautification Project provides existing commercial businesses the opportunity to receive a 50% cash max up to a \$500 maximum reimbursement from the City of Angleton. Butterfly Gardening:

Installation of the beds, install weed cloth, add ample dirt, add ornamental rock, install benches and Monarch Waystation sign and plant a number of different plants and flower, around the city to bring more monarchs.

Yard & Business of the Month:

April through October, the KAB board members pick one residence and one business each month to honor for their commitment to beautifying Angleton, one yard at a time.

Conservation & Preservation Workshops:

Water Conservation Plan presentation targeted to individuals, educators and civic groups which are interested in learning the basic principles of rainwater harvesting. The presentation includes background on water resources in Texas from the state water plan and an overview of the components of basic rainwater harvesting systems. The presentation is not intended for actual design of a system or for certification of system designers or installers.

City-Wide Tree planting:

Calling all Angleton residents. Join us for our Texas Arbor Day City-wide Tree planting. The great need for trees in the wake of natural disasters. Through this program the lost trees in major disasters caused by wildfires, floods, hurricanes, tornadoes, and insects this will replace the trees to plant in the city and local parks tree canopy for shade and recreational play. This work is critical for re-establishing the Angleton tree population...as well as a sense of community.
