- Monitoring and Data Analysis


Investigators also engage in special projects to identify and reduce pollution within the City.




## Indoor Air Quality equipment used to detect moisture












Examples of how the FLIR Camera detects moisture





### BioWatch: A Brief Overview

 Mission Statement: To operate a nationwide, aerosol detection system providing early warning across all levels of government to support public health and emergency management communities to prepare for and respond to biological incidents.





#### Criteria Pollutants Monitoring Team

Criteria Pollutants Team

- Collects quality data that determine NAAQS compliance for O3, PM, CO, SO2, NO2, Pb and PM
- Ambient (OUTDOOR) air monitoring at 8 fixed sites
- Performs the monitoring according to Sections 103 and 105 of the Clean Air Act, funded thru EPA and TCEQ grants
