I. <u>OVERVIEW</u>

Per Umbrella Contract 582-14-42709-2, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) requested Public Outreach support from the Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) for E&W Bacteria TMDL project, with activities for all elements of Public Outreach including, but not necessarily limited to:

- Identifying and Reserving Facilities for Meetings and / or Events;
- Providing a Facilitator for Any Meetings (As Needed);
- Providing Support for Organizing and Advertising Meetings and / or Events;
- Distribution and Posting of Meeting Agenda(s);
- Preparation of Meeting and / or Event Summaries;
- Preparation of Printed or Other Presentation Materials in Support of a Meeting and / or Event;
- Use of the H-GAC Website for Posting Meeting and / or Event Information; and
- Any Other Necessary Support Activities.

On April 13, 2015 (Round 6), H-GAC conducted a Coordination Committee meeting to discuss the results of discussions with the BIG's Coordination and Policy Workgroup on the E&W joining the BIG. In addition the group discussed the draft support letter, future watershed planning activities and next steps.

II. <u>PURPOSE</u>

The water bodies included in this analysis are all within the Lake Houston watershed, which originates in Walker, San Jacinto and Grimes and run through Montgomery, Liberty, and Harris counties.

The Purpose of this meeting was to discuss the following:

- 2. Review draft support letter;
- 3. Watershed planning activities; and
- 4. Discuss next steps and consider next meeting date.

Meeting Outcomes

- The committee met for approximately two hours.
- The Coordination Committee discussed results of the BIG Coordination and Policy meeting. Results included the tentative recommendation of 6 seats (3 County, 2 Agriculture, and 1 small local government) on the BIG to represent the watershed. H-GAC noted that it would still require the BIG to vote its approval at the next BIG meeting.
- The Coordination Committee reviewed the draft support letter and provided comments. The committee discussed the need to secure local support letters in addition to the support letter from the coordination committee. The committee voted to approve the Coordination Committee support letter as presented.
- The committee heard from representatives of the SJRA, Trust for Public Lands, and the H-GAC. All three organizations are carrying out watershed protection and planning activities. SJRA is in the process of completing a watershed protection plan for the Lake Conroe watershed. The plan will primarily be an internal document but the organization has sought input from the region to inform the agency on important watershed protection activities to consider. The Trust for Public Lands has received a Houston Endowment Grant to conduct a green print on the Lake Houston watershed to assist regional planners, organizations, and local governments to prioritize projects to preserve the water quality of the watershed. H-GAC is in the process of securing 319 funding to complete a watershed protection plan for the West Fork of the San Jacinto River.
- The committee reviewed the next steps which included completing a support letter, securing support letters from member organizations and those outside the committee. H-GAC staff announced the upcoming BIG Annual Meeting scheduled for May 26, 2015.
