

#### **About the Temporary Pedestrian/Bicycle Counters**

The Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) has temporary counters (TRAFx Infrared Trail Counters: Generation III) that can be borrowed by local governments and transportation agencies to count the number of people using off-street pedestrian and bicycle facilities. Infrared technology is used to count the number of people passing the counter. The counters do not differentiate between pedestrians and bicyclists, but count the total number of users.

The Texas Transportation Institute (TTI) owns additional temporary counters that it deploys along off-street pedestrian and bicycle facilities statewide.








Image 1: Brays Bayou Trail at Pasadena Street Facing East



Image 2: Brays Bayou Trail at Pasadena Street Facing West










Image 3: Brays Bayou Trail at Gus Wortham Golf Course Facing East






Image 7: Brays Bayou Trail – Telephone Road Access Facing East










Image 9: Brays Bayou Trail – Old Spanish Trail Access

Image 10: Brays Bayou Trail – Old Spanish Trail Access Facing West








Image 23: Harrisburg Sunset Trail at Avenue Q Facing North



Image 24: Harrisburg Sunset Trail at Avenue Q Facing South








Image 15: Harrisburg Trail at Lockwood Drive Facing East




Image 16: Harrisburg Trail at Lockwood Drive Facing West






Image 17: Harrisburg Trail at Drennan Street Facing East

### Why is Usage High during Afternoon Hours?

At Counter D, daily usage was quite variable. Pedestrian/bicycle volumes tended to increase dramatically during the afternoon hours. Below are possible explanations as to why counts may be high at certain times. Another deployment at this location may be necessary to confirm the data collected and validate these possibilities.

#### Mowing

Vacant lots surround Counter D. Crews mowing in the area could have been counted as pedestrians/cyclists.

### Pedestrians/Cyclists Traveling to/from Destinations North of Interstate 610

Near Counter D, there is a pedestrian bridge across Hunting Bayou. This pedestrian bridge provides the most direct access between surrounding neighborhoods and destinations along and north of Interstate 610. There is a worn path from the bridge to a sidewalk along the Interstate 610 eastbound frontage road, and it curves to the east. Pedestrians and cyclists traveling from destinations north of I-610 (METRO Kashmere Operations Facility, McDade Elementary School, Francis Scott Key Middle School, Barbara Jordan High School, etc.) may cross the freeway at Hirsch Road, walk along the frontage road, and then use the pedestrian bridge to access surrounding neighborhoods.



## Illegal Dumping/Burning

There was evidence of illegal dumping and burning near the counter. People dumping and burning garbage may have generated activity in the area and been counted as pedestrians/cyclists.






Image 21: Hunting Bayou Trail at Coal Street Facing North




Image 22: Hunting Bayou Trail at Coal Street Facing South


