H-GAC Seeks Proposals for Transportation Call for Projects

Houston, TX – The Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) seeks proposals from local governments, public transportation agencies, and other eligible sponsors to implement transportation projects within the eight-county transportation management area. The area includes Brazoria, Chambers, Fort Bend, Galveston, Harris, Liberty, Montgomery, and Waller Counties.

The 2018 Call for Projects will commit federal and state funds allocated to the Houston-Galveston region to implement highway, freight, transit, bicycle, and pedestrian projects. Approximately \$920 million of flexible funding including the local match is available for programming in the next 10 years (FY 2019 – FY 2028). Project applicants may begin the online application process from Sep. 4 through Oct. 31, 2018 by 5 p.m.
