Dear Mr. Wilson:

We have reviewed the documentation supporting the transportation conformity determination for amendments to the Houston-Galveston Area Council's (H-GAC) 2035 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) Update and FY 2013-2016 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), adopted by the H-GAC's Transportation Policy Council on May 24, 2013. Based upon our review and consultation with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ), and the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), we hereby find that the amended 2035 RTP Update and FY 2013-2016 TIP meet all the requirements for making a joint conformity determination under the Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990, subject to the enclosed comments.

This conformity determination addresses the requirement that a conformity determination be completed within one-year of the area's non-attainment designation in accordance with the 2008 8-hour ozone standard by EPA. This action does not restart the 4-year update cycle associated with H-GAC's 2035 RTP Update and corresponding conformity determination of January 25, 2011.

Interagency consultative partners indicate that they have no unresolved issues concerning this conformity determination in letters dated July 17, 2013 for EPA, July 17, 2013 for TxDOT, and July 16, 2013 for TCEQ. The conformity determination and procedures used to make this determination are in accordance with the provisions of the transportation conformity rule (40 CFR Parts 51 and 93), dated August 15, 1997, as amended.

FHWA acts as executive agent for the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) on MTP and TIP air quality conformity determinations. Accordingly, this letter will serve as the joint FHWA/FTA conformity determination. Should you have any questions concerning this action, please contact Jose M.
