- 4. Redesign the streets in downtown to distinguish the vehicular access roles of This Way and That Way from the more pedestrian and parking oriented roles of Parking Way, South Parking Place, North Parking Place, and Circle Way. Design the mojor vehicular routes to discourage unrelated through traffic movements and speeding vehicles.
- 5. Redesign and reconstruct parking areas so as to both increase the number of parking spaces and provide more extensive landscaping. The existing parking areas could provide more parking spaces by aligning spaces perpendicular to the curb line rather than the existing diagonal layout.
- 6. When freeway improvements are made to SH 288, maintain This Way as a continuous route linking downtown and the Plantation Village area. Reconstruct and handscape This Way so that it serves as both an attractive entrance to downtown and as a pedestrian and bicycle route, as well as a vehicular link between these two major commercial areas.

- Redesign and reconstruct street intersections to clearly delineate and make safer pedestrian crossings by reducing the distance of crosswalks and differentiating the crossings from the streets and parking areas by paving materials and landscaping.
- Eract regulations prohibiting additional disruption of street frontages by curb cuts serving individual parcels and require restoration of the ourbs and landscaping when major reconstruction of existing structures occur or existing structures are replaced by new construction.




Figure 4-9: Circle Way




# **Parking Count**




# **Existing Awnings Removal – North Parking Place**
