


## Spring Creek Watershed Protection Plan




#### Watershed Area






#### Land Cover





### **Status of Spring Creek**



WATERSHED PARTNERSHIP

- Impaired for contact recreation
  - High bacteria concentrations indicate presence of fecal waste
- Concerns for aquatic life
  - Low dissolved oxygen
  - Excess nitrogen and phosphorous

WATERSHED PARTNERSHIP

The TCEQ and H-GAC are establishing a watershed partnership to develop a **Watershed Protection Plan** (WPP) which will be:

- Non-regulatory
- A guide to addressing water quality concerns, estimating a timeline for progress and identifying helpful resources
- A vehicle for attracting funding
- Led by a local stakeholder partnership


