

SB 712 & HB 2489 PASSED

Renaming the Texas Natural Resources Information System as the Texas Geographic Information Office

HB 693, SB 115, HB 2294 Texas Redistricting Commission or redistricting related

HB 1676 The sale of consumer geotracking data by telephone companies

HB 3 Relating to measures for ensuring **public school safety**, including the development and implementation of purchases relating to and funding for **public school safety and security requirements** and the provision of safety-related resources.


<u>HB 2032</u>, <u>SB 866</u> A requirement that school districts and open-enrollment charter schools provide emergency response mapping data to local law enforcement agencies

<u>HB 13</u> Training, preparedness, and funding for school safety and school safety emergencies

<u>HB 2033</u> The inclusion of the Texas Department of Transportation on the Texas **Electricity Supply Chain Security and Mapping Committee** <u>SB 2472</u> Transmission and distribution utility access to certain portions of the **electricity supply chain map**







2023 StratMap Land Parcels and Address Points





Coastal Change Analysis Program (C-CAP)



- FGDC National Geospatial Data Asset
- Coastal expression of the NLCD
- Regional Products at 30-meter
 - Updated every 5 years (1996 2016)
 - Back as far as 1975 in some locations
 - 2021 update planned (2023 release)
- High Resolution Products at 1-meter
 - Historically expensive to produce
 - Faster, cheaper, better now possible
 - 2021 national buildout (by 2025)




Comparison of Resolutions

REGIONAL (30 METER)






LOCAL (1 METER)





1-meter Land Cover Production Goals

- C-CAP scheme land cover (Phase 2 short-term)
 - Tampa, FL (5.5 counties): Available now
 - Houston, TX (11 counties): Summer/Fall 2023 (In Progress)
 - Maine (statewide): Fall/Winter 2023
- C-CAP scheme land cover and change (Phase 2 mid-term)
 - Puerto Rico and U.S. Virgin Islands: Spring 2024
 - Hawaii, American Samoa, Guam, Northern Mariana Islands: Spring 2024
 - Puget, WA (Existing 2015, 2017 areas): TBD 2024
 - Erie County, OH; Charleston, SC; Brunswick and New Hanover, NC: TBD 2024
 - Rhode Island; New Hampshire; Massachusetts; Connecticut: TBD 2024
 - New Orleans, LA: TBD 2024
- C-CAP scheme land cover and change nationally (by 2025)
