
About the Temporary Pedestrian/Bicycle Counters


The Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) has three temporary counters (TRAFx Infrared Trail Counters: Generation III) that can be borrowed by local governments and transportation agencies to count the number of people using off-street pedestrian and bicycle facilities. Infrared technology is used to count the number of people passing the counter. The counters do not differentiate between pedestrians and bicyclists, but count the total number of users.


Image 3: Trail along Fairmont Parkway Facing West




Image 4: Trail along Fairmont Parkway Facing East




Image 5: Trail along Fairmont Parkway Facing West




Image 6: Trail along Fairmont Parkway Facing East
