

# What is Discover Downtown Rosenberg



### WHERE ARE WE GOING AND HOW DID WE GET HERE?

- Discover Downtown Program was created in 2021 when City Council approved a necessary rebranding.
- The program was moved under the City's Communications Department.
- The Communications Department also oversees: Communications, Community Engagement, Event Production, the Historic District, Tourism & the Arts, Rosenberg Civic Center, Volunteer Program and the Recreation program.

### DISCOVER DOWNTOWN ROSENBERG

The Program is responsible for serving as a partner and providing a City liaison to the 100+ Downtown Rosenberg Merchants to foster continued success and vitality in the district. We manage the oversight of the historic downtown and are responsible for all special event production, marketing and tourism efforts, and physical improvements throughout our Historic Downtown District.













Whether you're interested in cultural arts, shopping, dining or history, there is so much to do in Rosenberg's Historic Downtown.



Historic Downtown is home to the 1910 Vogelsang Building, a Texas Historic Landmark and to Another Time Soda Fountain, winner of a Texas Downtown Association Restoration Award, and the Cole Theatre which will undergo a renovation to help restore it to its original Art Deco glamour!

Historic Downtown Rosenberg is the first and only state-designated Cultural District in Fort Bend County, and home to a burgeoning cultural arts scene led by the Rosenberg Arts Alliance. A collaboration of business owners, artists, and community leaders have converged to help make Rosenberg the center of arts activities for Fort Bend County and beyond.


# WATER TOWER SQUARE

Water Tower Square located at 2100 Ave G in Historic Downtown Rosenberg, has quickly become a beloved community gathering space and a vibrant hub in the heart of our downtown district. Once an eye sore, and vacant lot for decades, the greenspace is now a lively focal point for residents and visitors, hosting live music, community events, selfie stations, public art and more. In 2021, the City of Rosenberg's Communications Department took over management of Historic Downtown Rosenberg and began exploring ways to revitalize the area with a focus on placemaking. Upon discovering the city already owned the lot, the department took action, and began transforming the space in 2022. The lot was officially named Water Tower Square due to being located under the City's water tower. Today, the square features a stage, permanent light towers, turf, decorative sidewalks, a message board, and a striking metal art sign. The water tower is currently being repainted.








## Downtown Events

- Hometown Holiday Festival






















## The Vogelsang Building Constructed in 1910


