RECOGNIZING AND HONORING THE SERVICE OF COMMISSIONER KENNETH CLARK

WHEREAS, Commissioner Kenneth Clark served as Past-Chair of the Transportation Policy Council from January 2022 until May 2022; and

WHEREAS, Commissioner Kenneth Clark served as the Chairman of the Transportation Policy Council from January 2019 until December 2021 and served as a member of the TPC for 19 years; and

WHEREAS, Commissioner Clark represented Galveston County Precinct 4 which included the communities of Kemah, League City, Clear Lake Shores and Friendswood since 1998; and

WHEREAS, Commissioner Clark was born in Waukesha, Wisconsin in May 1963. He graduated from Random Lake High School in Random Lake, Wisconsin. Commissioner Clark and his family moved to Galveston County in 1988, where he and his family raised horses and livestock and were avid horticulturists; and

WHEREAS, Commissioner Kenneth Clark was married to his wife, Sherry, for 34 years and raised seven children; and

WHEREAS, Commissioner Clark was a strong advocate for developing an efficient and effective regional transportation system for the Houston-Galveston region;
