Evaluate the Effectiveness of Stormwater Implementation Activities

In December 2010, the National Stormwater BMP Database published the <u>"Pollutant Category Summary: Fecal Indicator Bacteria"</u> which examines and summarizes findings included within the database.

In general, conclusions indicate that more data and analysis are needed. Based on current data, the category of BMP most likely to be effective is retention (wet) ponds. Source controls and volume reduction may also be effective at reducing bacteria loads.
