5B. Transportation Safety Committee Update

BACKGROUND

On October 26, 2018, the Transportation Policy Council (TPC) changed the name of the Regional Safety Council to the Transportation Safety Committee (TSC). The committee was established by the Transportation Policy Council to improve road safety in the region. Membership includes officials from local and State governments, transportation, law enforcement, health care, insurance, trucking, railroads and non-profit organizations involved in safety. The purpose is to promote information-sharing, establish safety goals and performance measures, coordinate safety efforts across the region's jurisdictions, and identify policy issues concerning safety.

The TSC has historically experienced low engagement, and a concerted effort by TPC to revise the TSC has been underway for a few months. In March 2025, the TSC achieved quorum for the first time in a long time with a dramatic increase in membership.
