Two off-leash areas

- 1. Top of hill at Shelly and Mansell
- 2. Southsection via 1600 block of Geneva or 1600 block of Sunnydale - exclusive of Sensitive

East end of park, north of Lake St. at 8th Ave.



Potrero Hill Mini-Park

(22nd St. and Arkansas) 22nd St. between Arkansas and Connecticut.

(19th Ave, and Wawona) North side, Wawona, between 21st and 23rd Aves.

Areas adjacent to ball field; east of first base line, south of third base line.

Areas open to voice control dogwalking, although officials prefer owners use leashes:


- 1. Fort Funston (except 12-acre closure at northwest end)









#### Circles are sized to reflect how many more singles there are in each metro area, by gender











#### Inflow/Outflow Job Counts in 2013




































#### Total consumer expenditures on Dining out (Food away from home) (\$)



- State Context (for reference only)




#### Inputs and Capacity

The ability of the population and labor force to innovate is captured in 2 component indexes that include inputs into local economies.




