Call to Order/Welcome/Introductions

Mr. Steven Johnston of H-GAC welcomed all in attendance.

Mr. Johnston reviewed the agenda with members of the BIG. He asked if there were any changes or additions to the Agenda by BIG members. Hearing no requests for changes and no call for discussion, the meeting proceeded.

Certification of Quorum

Mr. Johnston called roll. The number of BIG members and alternates in attendance sufficed and a quorum was certified.

Approval of the October 29, 2024, Meeting Summary

The BIG was asked to consider the October meeting summary. The BIG discussed reviewed the summary. The October 29, 2024, meeting summary was approved.

Public Comment

No public comments were made.

Item One: I-Plan Update

Mr. Johnston reviewed progress to date. He noted that the work groups would be scheduled in July and August. The groups will be asked for final edits and comments. The document will then be reviewed by the Coordination and Policy work group for final review.

Item Two: 2024 Annual Report

Mr. Johnston reviewed progress the 2024 report. He mentioned that he still needed input from the BIG, to identify implementation success stories and other related information. Current

potential stories include targeted monitoring efforts and a green infrastructure efficacy study. The work groups will be asked to provide additional information for the report.

Item Three: 2025 Annual Report

Mr. Johnston reviewed progress in gathering implementation data for the 2025 report. He noted that H-GAC had completed the annual data analysis. He mentioned that he will be seeking information from the work groups.

Item Four: TMDL Updates

Ms. Sophia Staska, TCEQ TMDL Program, provided the update. She stated H-GAC is collecting new water quality data within the Tarkington and Luce Bayou watersheds. The project is in response to a new contact recreation 303(d) listing for Tarkington Bayou.

Item Five: Texas Watershed Coordinators Roundtable Report

The roundtable presented bacteria identification and health risk information and research. A few stakeholders attended the meeting, and one wished to present a review of the roundtable and information that might be important for the BIG. Due to illness, the report was not presented, but a follow up report will be made. The topic will be continued as the BIG looks to narrow focus towards greater targeted bacteria reduction in the region.

Item Six: Green Infrastructure for Texas

Mr. Michael Niebuhr is a Green Infrastructure Coordinator for the Texas Coastal Partners - Texas AgriLife. He reviewed the Green Infrastructure for Texas or GIFT program. The program's focus is to increase the use of Green Infrastructure through education via workshops, online resources, and demonstrations. Their target audiences include local governments, master naturalists, and high schools. They have an online course the introduces the topic through a self-paced program. They have created an internship program with local high schools. The GIFT program provides technical assistance for on the ground projects. Mr. Niebuhr announced an upcoming workshop on August 29, 2025 in Mont Belvieu.

Item Seven: Implementation Project Presentations

Two presentations were given to the BIG.

H-GAC Staff Presentations

2025 Targeted Monitoring – Mr. Cornell Evens Jr. and Ms. Erica Underwood

Mr. Cornell Evans Jr. and Ms. Erica Underwood reported that the Halls Bayou watershed was the focus of the 2025 Targeted Monitoring. The watershed was picked due to the elevated levels of bacteria and that is supports the developing Greens Bayou watershed protection plan. The purpose of the project is to identify illicit discharges and other possible sources of bacteria and report those sources to the proper jurisdictions for removal. Over 122 samples were collected with most coming from a 6-mile target area. Nineteen referrals were made from the target are from four tributaries. Many of the results were above the detection limit of 242,000.

Clean Rivers Program Basin Highlights Report on the Tarkington and Luce Bayou Watershed – Dr. Jenny Oakley

Dr. Jenny Oakley reviewed the report prepared for the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality. The Tarkington and Luce Bayou watershed was chosen as that watershed is being investigated for a total maximum daily load project due to elevated levels of bacteria impacting contact recreation. Dr. Oakley noted that the document is available via the H-GAC website and that all data used in the report can be found on H-GAC's Water Resources Information Map. She reviewed highlights of the report and noted that the report will be available on June 30, 2025.

Item Eight: Other Business/Roundtable

H-GAC provided a slide on upcoming meetings and workshops. Mr. Johnston encouraged attendees to add to the list of upcoming events.
