INTRODUCTIONS

Chair Veronica Chapa-Gorczynski, called the Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC) meeting to order at 9:30 a.m.

Mr. Dickinson gave a brief presentation on Consent Agenda Item 4B). After the presentation, the Chair asked Mr. Craig Raborn to provide a brief update on the status of the Air Quality Conformity Determination. Mr. Raborn provided the update and advised the Committee that the amendments were still being given as recommendations. AGENDA ITEMS

PROJECT SELECTION PROCESS UPDATE

The presentation was given in two parts. Ms. Callie Barnes first presented on the status of Project Readiness evaluation. H-GAC requested Project Readiness Questionnaires for over 230 projects submitted as Projects of Interest for which the project sponsor indicated the project could let within a 0-3 year timeframe. Approximately

200 Project Readiness Questionnaires have been submitted. H-GAC is assessing the questionnaire responses and will be contacting local sponsors regarding project delivery schedules. Ms. Barnes further discussed how the questionnaire responses will be developed and the required planning steps to get the project into the TIP and STIP (Statewide Transportation Improvement Program).

Additionally, Ms. Barnes presented the Draft List of "Recommended Carryover Balance Spend Down Projects" to the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Subcommittee, Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC) and Transportation Policy Council (TPC) in October 2023 for information only. H-GAC will address any comments received from the committees and council, then present the Final List of "Carryover Balance Spend Down Projects" to the TIP Subcommittee, TAC and TPC in November 2023 for Action.

In the second half of this presentation, Mr. Vishu Lingala presented on the status of the Regional Goods Movement (RGM) projects benefit/cost analysis (BCA) and the next five investment categories. In July sponsors submitted project costs and benefits for 40 RGM projects that scored at least 50/100 points in draft evaluation scoring. A table was provided to show a summary of RGM and BCA submitted. Staff are reviewing and finalizing benefit calculations submitted for RGM projects and conducting follow up meetings with the sponsors. Mr. Lingala then discussed with the Committee the next five investment categories as to how the projects will be reviewed. UPDATE ON CONNECT SMART

Mr. Emmanuel Andrews introduced Ms. Brenda Bustillos with TxDOT, to give the update on ConnectSmart Program and recognize the programs' one year anniversary. The Texas Department of Transportation Houston District's ConnectSmart Program launched September 16, 2022, providing integrated trip planning and navigation across a wide array of mode options, including carpooling. Other features include toll rates on routes, Tow and Go™ request button, high-comfort bike lane routing, and BCycle station locations as well as the ability to purchase, store, and redeem digital transit tickets right in the app. The program provides a critical element in regional congestion mitigation efforts as it enables Active Demand Management strategies to help advance the region's Transportation Systems Management & Operations goals. The Houston-Galveston Area Council, through Commute Solutions and Tow and Go, is one of several partners to the ConnectSmart program. To hear more about this update please click on the link below.
