1. Call to Order/Certify Quorum and Introductions

Chair Clark Martinson called the meeting to order and confirmed that Quorum was met. The members of the Pedestrian-Bicyclist Subcommittee introduced themselves for the record. Also, Chair Martinson stated that he had to leave the meeting early and turned the meeting over to Monique Johnson, Vice-Chair, City of Sugar Land.

2. Public Comments

There were no Public Comments.

3. Approval of Minutes for June 12, 2017 meeting (Chair Clark Martinson)

The minutes of the June 12, 2017 meeting were approved as presented.

DISCUSSION

4. Outcomes from Safety Workshops (Ms. Diane Dohm, H-GAC)

Ms. Diane Dohm, H-GAC, briefed the committee on the outcome of two Safety Workshops that occurred in July and September. Some key issues brought up by attendees were regarding safety and the differences in bicycle and pedestrian crashes, injuries, time of day, day of week and location. Ms. Dohm provided a preliminary list of high crash areas. Ms. Dohm mentioned plans for two FHWA Workshops in 2018 with locations to be determined and future work with FHWA to develop a Regional Pedestrian and Bicyclist Safety Plan in 2018-2019.

5. Safety Outreach (Ms. Jessica Wiggins, Bike Houston)

Ms. Jessica Wiggins, Bike Houston, briefed the committee on Bike Houston's mission and described their outreach efforts to improve safety for bicyclists in the City of Houston and the surrounding area. Ms. Wiggins requested committee members to provide suggestions on how to improve safety for bicyclists at intersections. Some suggestions from members included:

- Enhanced striping or bike lane designation at or through intersections and underpasses
- Coordination between City of Houston and TxDOT on bike lane striping at intersections
- Enhanced signals or lights that would designate safe bike lanes to motorists

6. Nonmotorized Safety Measure and Target (Mr. Patrick Mandapaka, H-GAC)

Mr. Patrick Mandapaka, H-GAC, discussed nonmotorized safety measures and targets for the Houston-Galveston Area Council region for 2022. MPO targets are due to the state by February 2018.

7. Priority Investment Matrix (Mr. David Wurdlow, H-GAC)

Mr. David Wurdlow, H-GAC, discussed Regional Transportation Plan investment strategies and options in the Houston-Galveston including First Mile/Last Mile Gaps, Pedestrian Safety Treatments, ADA Improvements of the Pedestrian Network, and Expansion of the Regional Bikeway System. Group discussion followed the presentation.

8. Strava Data (Ms. Diane Dohm, H-GAC)

Ms. Diane Dohm, H-GAC, discussed workshops held by TxDOT in September regarding Strava data. Ms. Dohm also briefed the subcommittee on what the requirements are for local agencies to gain access to the full dataset and where to get more information. Ms. Dohm described what information local agencies could share after accessing Strava data and other resources.

- 9. Regional Pedestrian & Bicycle Plan Update (Ms. Diane Dohm, H-GAC)
 - Ms. Diane Dohm, H-GAC, discussed the key tasks in the Regional Pedestrian and Bicycle Plan Update, including updating and printing the Regional Bicycle Map. Ms. Dohm provided a timeline on those efforts, which will finalize in the Fall of 2018. Ms. Dohm requested volunteers from the committee to form an advisory workgroup to help with the update. Ms. Dohm also discussed the use of a partner outreach survey and public outreach survey that will occur in early 2018. Ms. Dohm suggested the use of local partners to assist in the distribution of the public outreach survey. Group discussion followed the presentation.
- 10. **Regional Pedestrian-Bicyclist Traffic Monitoring Program (Ms. Diane Dohm, H-GAC)**Ms. Diane Dohm, H-GAC, described H-GAC's Regional-Bicyclist Traffic Monitoring Program, including the locations for permanent and temporary counters. Ms. Dohm requested members to contact her if they wished to install a permanent counter in their jurisdiction. Group discussion followed the presentation.
