#### ITEM 4. Safe Streets for All (SS4A) (Susan Jaworski)

Susan Jaworski provided an update on the Safe Streets for All program, highlighting a grant received by HGAC to enhance a region-wide safety action plan that includes eleven localized plans. A consultant has been selected for the project, which is set to begin in February.

#### **ITEM 5. Safety Committee Activity Report** (Robert Benz)

Robert Benz informed the committee members that he will be reporting to TAC and TPC what the committee will be doing regarding safety to get their input and ideas moving forward.

## ITEM 6. State of Safety Report: Discussion (Eric Pacheco)

The group discussed the annual safety report produced by the Houston Galveston Area Council, with calls for a revamp to make it more relevant and actionable. Participants emphasized the need to understand crash statistics to develop effective safety solutions and expressed a desire to enhance collaboration, particularly in integrating freight safety considerations into the report. The conversation shifted to the City of Houston's safety initiatives, with Brian Smith discussing the Highway Safety Improvement Plan (HSIP) funding and its relevance to the report. Ali Saeed confirmed ongoing HSIP projects and the annual submission process for project funding. The proposed report structure was discussed, which includes a comprehensive technical report, a five-page synopsis, and a one-page executive summary to cater to various stakeholders.

## ITEM 7. Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) Architecture and Website Update (Francis Rodriguez)

The meeting concluded with discussions on upcoming workshops related to Integrated Transportation Systems (ITS) and strategies to boost committee participation, including the potential for hybrid meeting formats to improve engagement and address attendance challenges.
