July 5- July 10

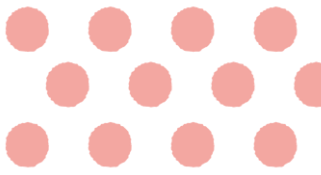
Election Day:

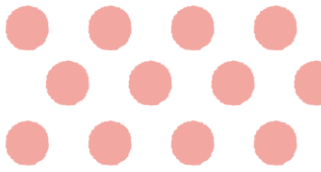


July Primary Runoff Elections



- A candidate who gets >50% +1 votes, wins the election. Otherwise, the top 2 candidates with the most votes go to a Runoff Election.
- You must choose 1 of the political parties (Democratic or Republican) to vote, but not both parties. There is no restriction on which party you choose. Texas follows the “Open Primary” election.
- What you vote in the Primary Election does not affect you in the November General Election. You can choose any candidates of any party.

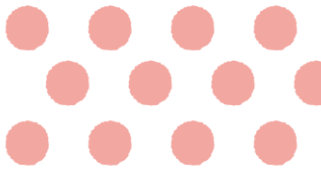

Voting Safely



- **Wear a face covering** that fits snugly against your face.
- **Maintain a 6 foot distance from others**
- **Wash your hands frequently**
- **Consider voting early** as a way to avoid any lines or potentially crowded polling locations.
- **Stay at home** if you have fever, respiratory symptoms, or believe you are sick.

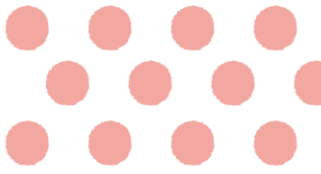




Voting By Mail



Who can vote by mail?



You may vote early by-mail if you are registered to vote and meet one of the following criteria:

- Away from the county of residence on Election Day and during the early voting period;
- Sick or disabled
- 65 years of age or older on Election Day
- Confined in jail, but eligible to vote
