NEW FOR FY2026/2027 REQUEST FOR PROJECT APPLICATION

PROJECT FEASIBILITY

As part of the Project Feasibility question in the application, you must describe your backup plan should your project come in under budget once implemented. All proposed ideas must fall under the same project category as the originally funded project.

GRANT ENDING DATE

In past bienniums, all grants ended on June 30 of the second year of the biennium. For this call for applications all grants must end on May 31 of the second year of the biennium (2027).
