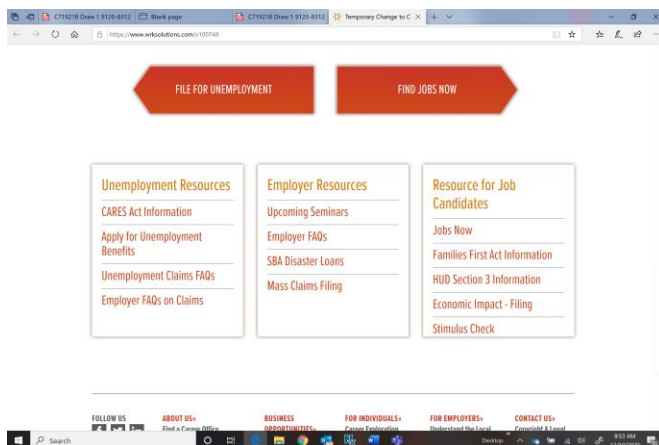

More than 50 years ago, President Lyndon Johnson signed the Civil Rights Act of 1968 into law, prohibiting discrimination in housing. The Fair Housing Act (Title VII of that law) prohibits discrimination in housing because of race or color, national origin, religion, sex, familial status, or disability. The act applies to rental properties, properties for sale, and mortgage lending.

April is Fair Housing Month

The Fair Housing Act prohibits discrimination in housing based on race, color, religion, national origin, sex, disability, or familial status. The act applies to rental properties, properties for sale, and mortgage lending.

Recent layoffs and furloughs in the wake of COVID-19 have left many in the region struggling to pay their rent or mortgage. In response, the Federal Housing Finance Agency has directed Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac to suspend foreclosures and evictions for at least 60 days. Mortgage payments may be suspended for up to a year for borrowers impacted by COVID-19 with federally backed mortgages. The national emergency declaration included a foreclosure and eviction moratorium for all USDA Single Family Housing Guaranteed Loans Program loans for a period of 60 days.
