2020 General Election Voting Information: The Harris County Clerk's Office provided the GDW with a final slideshow all about how to vote in the upcoming general election on November 3rd as well as an updated early voting schedule for the county complete with early voting locations and dates/times for all locations. 2020 Houston Area GIS Day Update: Nicole Ceranek with Montgomery County gave a brief update on the 2020 Houston Area GIS Day. Due to the pandemic, the decision was made to host the event virtually in unison with other GIS Day events from around the state to form the Texas GIS Day this year scheduled from Monday, November 16th to Wednesday, November 18th. The Houston Area GIS Day event will still be held for high school students within the Texas GIS Day schedule on Tuesday, November 17th. The Houston Area GIS Day event this year will feature virtual GIS labs, GeoMentors, panel discussions and "Behind the Scenes" videos, live GIS activities for students, and a virtual meet and greet and exhibit hall. The biggest need at this point is to gather additional volunteers to lead a GIS lab which involves about 30 minutes leading a pre-set up online GIS activity with students following along. 2020 Aerial Imagery Cost-Share Wrap-Up: Brooks Andrews with H-GAC gave the GDW an update on the 2020 Aerial Imagery Cost-Share project including updates on the final physical and digital project deliverables. Brooks noted that H-GAC processed and mailed out all but 2 of the 37 physical drives for cost-share participants last month. Brooks then discussed the digital imagery services specific to each 2020 Aerial Imagery Cost-Share participant and a bit of instruction on how to access them in three different Esri environments. H-GAC is needing all 37 license agreements back and so far have about half, so Brooks will be emailing to get the remaining half soon to have them signed by H-GAC and redelivered. The next imagery cost-share project will commence in Spring 2021.
