


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Overview

- Formula to allocate \$209,410,000
- Funding is for mitigation, not tied to individual disaster damage
- HUD and State Most Impacted areas
- 120-day timetable from contract start



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Considerations

- Consistent, publicly-available data to represent local mitigation needs
- Straightforward formula
- Appropriate split between HUD and State Most Impacted Counties
- Reasonable base allocation amounts



Mitigation Factors

- FEMA Individual Assistance Housing Data 2002-2019
 - Households applying for assistance
 - Real property and personal property damage
- Low-to-Moderate Income individuals
- Population within floodway, 100-year and 500-year flood plain



Allocation Formula Weights

- Households impacted 25%
- Personal and Real Property Damage 25%
- Low-to-Moderate Income population 20%
- Population within flood plain 30%



Base Allocations and Minimum Amounts

- HUD Most Impacted Counties \$2,000,000
- State Most Impacted Counties \$1,000,000
- Minimum jurisdiction allocation \$1,000,000
 - Cities with allocations <\$1,000,000 rolled up into county totals
