

## 10. SUBREGIONAL PLANNING UPDATE

### **BACKGROUND**

---

Subregional Planning is a partnership between H-GAC and local public agencies within the region where H-GAC assists in developing plans and conducting studies that focus on local transportation networks and ensure they align with the regional transportation network. These planning efforts enhance mobility by identifying needed roadway improvements for all types of transportation; promoting coordinated transportation project development between local governments and agencies; and providing guidance for future transportation needs.

H-GAC receives requests from local sponsors to conduct subregional planning initiatives through the Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) call for projects, and throughout the fiscal year after the UPWP call for projects has ended.

### **CURRENT SITUATION**

---

Staff will present an update on several subregional planning initiatives that are underway, as well as initiatives anticipated to begin by the end of 2025.
