### <u>CHANGES DUE TO 2021-2024 STIP FISCAL CONSTRAINT AND AMENDMENTS TO THE</u> 2021 TIP AND 2045 RTP

#### **Background**

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is a four-year program of regionally significant transportation projects. It is developed once every two years in close coordination with Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), local transit agencies and other local government agencies within the 8-county Transportation Management Area (TMA). It must be fiscally constrained, consistent with the Regional Transportation Plan (RTP), and the latest air quality conformity determination.

At the June 2020 meeting, the Transportation Policy Council (TPC) approve the Houston Galveston Area Council's (H-GAC) Fiscal Year 2021-2024 TIP. The 2021 TIP included a total programing of \$8.4 billion of federal, state and local funds for roadway projects in the next four years. It also includes a total programming of \$1.3 billion of federal state and local funds for capital, operations and planning of transit projects within the next four years.

H-GAC's adopted, a fiscally constrained 2021 TIP was submitted to TxDOT. It was not submitted to the Federal Highway Administration by TxDOT as Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) was not able to demonstrate fiscal constraint.

#### **Current Situation**

Since July the TxDOT's Transportation Planning and Programming division (TPP) worked with Houston and Beaumont Districts staff to move some projects between fiscal years within the STIP time frame and some out of the STIP timeframe to fiscally constrain the 2021 STIP. To reflect these changes to the 2021 TIP projects TxDOT Houston District is requesting the following changes to the 2021 TIP.

• Administratively amend the projects listed in Attachment - A – Information Only to move between fiscal years within the 2021 TIP.

Removal of projects listed in Attachment – B – Information Only. Project LET since the adoption of 2021 TIP. Summary of funding by category is provided in Table 1.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRANSPORTATION POLICY COUNCIL (TPC) FOR THE HOUSTON-GALVESTON TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT AREA THAT THE 2045 REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN AND THE 2021–2024 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM BE AMENDED TO REFLECT THE REVISIONS IDENTIFIED IN THE TABLE OF JANUARY 2021 TPC AMENDMENTS.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT FEDERAL FUNDS AUTHORIZED BY THE TPC FROM THE CONGESTION MITIGATION AND AIR QUALITY (CMAQ) AND SURFACE TRANSPORTATION BLOCK GRANT (STBG) PROGRAMS REPRESENT A LIMITING AMOUNT. ANY COST OVERRUNS ON PHASES OF WORK AUTHORIZED BY THE TPC OR COSTS INCURRED ON PHASES OF WORK NOT AUTHORIZED BY THE TPC SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PROJECT SPONSOR. IN NO CASE, SHALL FEDERAL PARTICIPATION UNDER THE CMAQ AND STBG PROGRAMS BE INCREASED WITHOUT CONSULTATION AND THE EXPRESS APPROVAL OF THE TPC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRANSPORTATION POLICY COUNCIL (TPC) FOR THE HOUSTON-GALVESTON TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT AREA THAT TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT CREDITS BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE HOUSTON-GALVESTON AREA COUNCIL (MPO ID 12092: H-GAC CLEAN VEHICLES FY 2021-2022 1.6M TDCS; MPO ID 18758: H-GAC MULTIMODAL NETWORK CONNECTIVITY PILOT STUDIES, 20K TDCS), AND THAT THE TRANSPORTATION DIRECTOR IS DIRECTED TO ENTER INTO ANY NECESSARY PROJECT AGREEMENTS.
