# 4. MINUTES OF THE TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE WEDNESDAY, August 18, 2021 9:30 A.M., ZOOM ONLINE MEETING

### **INTRODUCTIONS**

Chairman Smith entertained a motion to amend the meeting meetings. Mr. Morad Kabiri agreed to the motion to amend the meeting minutes. The second motion for approval was made by Ms. Ana Ramirez-Huerta. The Committee voted and the motion carried. The minutes were approved.

### AMENDMENTS TO THE 2021-2024 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) AND THE 2045 REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN (RTP)

Mr. Jim Dickinson presented on the amendments to the 2021-2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and the 2045 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP). Staff sought TAC Recommendation for TPC of Resolution No. 2021-21 which included the following amendments:

- Delay the TXDOT Houston District US 290 ramp construction project (MPOID 17041/CSJ 0050-06-093) in Harris County from FY 2022 to FY 2023 to allow for additional coordination with METRO (Total Cost: \$32M).
- Delay the City of League City Landing Boulevard extension project (MPOID 17080/CSJ 0912-00-519) from FY 2021 to FY 2023 due to delays in Right-of-Way acquisition (Total Cost: \$49M).
- Advance the City of Houston Westpark Drive widening project (MPOID 17094/CSJ 0912-72-385) from FY 2022 to FY 2021 to take advantage of its readiness for contract letting (Total Cost: \$12M).
- Delay the City of South Houston sidewalks construction project (MPOID 17119/CSJ 0912-72-397) from FY 2021 to FY 2022 due to survey and design issues (Total Cost: \$1.5M).
- Delay the METRO Regional Vanpool project (MPOID 17141/CSJ 0912-00-568) from FY 2021 to FY 2022 to allow for additional time to complete the contracting process with TXDOT. (Total Cost: \$1.3M).
- Update the City of Conroe's FY 2021 Federal Transit Administration Section 5307 Program of Projects with the actual apportionments for operating, capital and planning expenditures (MPOIDs 15218, 15219 and 15400) (Addition of Funds: \$0.3M).
- Program the Houston Urbanized Area's FY 2019 Federal Transit Administration Section 5310, Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities, in FY 2021 of the TIP. The Program of Projects was approved by the METRO Board of Directors on June 24, 2021. The funds were suballocated to Fort Bend County (MPOs 18261, 18262), Harris County (MPO ID 18263), East End District (MPO ID 18525), Near Northwest Management District (MPO ID 18526) and the Montrose Redevelopment Authority (MPO ID 18524) (Total Cost: \$3.4M).

A motion was made by Mr. Mike Wilson and a second motion for approval was made by Mr. Ken Fickes. The Committee voted and the motion carried.

Ms. Neely Kim presented on the 2022-2023 Unified Planning Work Program. Staff requested TAC recommendation for TPC approval of Resolution 2022/23-0. The UPWP is the two-year planning document that includes description of tasks and budget from October 1<sup>st</sup> to September 30<sup>th</sup> of each fiscal year. This plan describes the regional transportation plans and programs including air quality activities to be carried out within the Metropolitan Planning Area. The UPWP includes description of major planning activities, responsible parties, expected products, and a summary of the funding to be used. To review the

Staff requested TAC recommendation for TPC approval of Resolution No. 2021-24 to recognize September 2021 as Commute Solutions Month.

### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) WITH TRANSIT AGENCIES FOR THE REGIONAL TRANSIT CONNECTIVITY PROJECT

Mr. Thomas Gray provided an update on the MOU with transit agencies for the Regional Transit Connectivity project. Mr. Gray gave an overview of examples of other Regional Transit Connectivity projects in other Metro areas. An MOU between H-GAC, METRO, and the region's eight other transit providers is now circulating for signature. This MOU will guide role of participating agencies and the expected outcomes of this effort. An Intergovernmental Agreement between H-GAC and METRO is under development to fund METRO's contractor to begin the work on assessments of the eight transit agencies. Staff is working with area transit agencies to develop and publish mapping data, and to prepare information for other applications (Google Maps, Apple Maps, ConnectSmart, the regional TripPlanner).

TAC recommended to the TPC to instruct Staff to Develop a new Predevelopment and Readiness Program at the July 14, 2021 meeting. The recommendation to TPC was tabled and will be discussed later.
