RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT AND FUNDING COMMITMENT FOR 2018 CALL FOR PROJECTS SUBMISSIONS

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE EAST END DISTRICT, A GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY AND POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OF TEXAS, FOR THE SUPPORT AND FUNDING COMMITMENT OF A GRANT APPLICATION THROUGH THE HOUSTON-GALVESTON AREA COUNCIL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM CALL FOR PROJECTS (PUBLIC PARKING TRANSPPORATION PROJECT)

WHEREAS, the East End District, formerly known as the Greater East End Management District (District) has been working with Houston METRO and other project partners to evaluate the potential of a shared use public transportation parking project along the Houston METRO Green Line;

WHEREAS, in support of this effort, the District has developed several planning documents and agreements relative to the implementation and proposed lease of approximately 250 shared use parking spaces for a public transportation purpose;

WHEREAS, the District requires discretionary funding to be able to realize the project;

WHEREAS, the Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) has issued the 2018 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Call for Projects;

WHEREAS, the District is a grantee of the Federal Transit Administration and has the documented capability to apply for, manage, deliver, and administer all grant funds awarded, as previously demonstrated through successful grant-related project delivery;

WHEREAS, the District shall be able to utilize property value, conveyed to the District via a 40-year ground lease, as the required local share commitment as established by H-GAC; and

WHEREAS, if funded, the District agrees to establish agreements for the maintenance and operation of all grant-funded improvements for their useful life per Federal Transit Administration requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE EAST END DISTRICT THAT:

- Section 1. The District Board hereby authorizes the submittal of all required data and information to support a request for the pursuit of discretionary funding.
- Section 2. The District Board hereby authorizes the use of property value conveyed to the District to provide the local match requirement for the project.
- Section 3. The District Board hereby recognizes that the District will, if the projects are funded, agree to establish agreements for the maintenance and operation of such funded improvements.
 - Section 4. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
