SUBJECT: West Gulf Bank Road, from I-45 to Airline Drive; Harris County; 2018 HGAC Call for Projects


Dear Mr. Blount:

This is the City of Houston's letter of support for Harris County's submission of the West Gulf Bank Road project application towards HGAC's 2018 Call for Projects. This important added capacity and safety project will involve upgrading the existing 2-lane asphalt pavement with ditches to 4-lane concrete boulevard section with sidewalks.

The project is on the National Highway System; therefore, it will be designed and constructed to TxDOT standards. The portion of the project from I-45 to Sweetwater Lane is within the City of Houston; therefore, the city will ultimately own and maintain this section. Harris County will own and maintain the section outside the City of Houston limits.

Upon successful receipt of grant funding, Harris County will be responsible for 20% of the construction costs, and federal funding will be used for the remaining 80%. The City of Houston will be responsible for 100% of city utility upgrades or relocations within city limits.
