Dear Director Raborn:

This letter is in support of a select number of Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Houston District's projects submitted for funding consideration in the **Houston-Galveston Area Council's (H-GAC) 2023 Call for Projects**.

We concur with the following TxDOT projects and agree that they currently share the City's strategic priorities; however, this list must not be construed as a ranking of priorities. Please see the following concurrence list:

- **0027-09-111 UA 90A At Griggs:** Road Reconstruct Pump Station and Install New Detention Pond.
- **0027-13-242 IH 69 At Hazard Street:** Rehabilitate pump station including baffles, trash collection system and control system and address concrete flatwork settling.
- **0027-13-243 IH 69 At Mandell Street:** Rehabilitate pump station, improve trash collection system, and upgrade control system.
- **0028-02-097 US 90 From W of Greens Bayou to E of Greens Bayou:** Construct bridge (6 Main Lanes) over Greens Bayou in gap of US 90 mainlanes.
- **0051-02-110 SH 3 At South Richey, Edgebrook Dr, El Dorado Blvd, and Bay Area Blvd:** Change signals to mast arms, replace railroad arms, and gates, and lengthen railroad planking. The purpose of the project is to extend sidewalks across the RR tracks parallel to SH 3.
- **0110-06-132 IH 45 From South of West Rd to SL 8:** Reconstruct 8 Main Lanes, Reconstruct and widen from 1 to 4 managed lanes transitioning into two entering and existing lanes at reversible HOV lane north of SL8, and reconstruct and widen from two 2 and 3-lane frontage roads to two 2 and 3-lane frontage roads (NHHIP SEG 1D).
- **0110-06-139 IH 45 From South of Shepherd Drive to South of West Road:** Reconstruct/Widen from 8 to 10 mainlanes, reconstruct/Widen from 1 to 4 managed lanes, reconstruct/widen from two 2 and 3-lanes frontage roads to two 2-and 3-lane frontage roads (NHHIP Seg 1C)
- **0271-07-334 IH 10 From IH 10 south through Memorial Park (Adjacent to Polo Fields):** Construct detention pond upgrades, construct outfall channel adjacent to polo fields and provide pump station upgrades.
- **0500-03-446 IH 45 N From Airline Dr to South of Shepherd Dr:** Reconstruct Main Lanes, construct 4 managed lanes, and Reconstruct and Widen from two 2-In frontage roads to two 3-In frontage roads (NHHIP Seg 1B)

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- **0500-03-644 IH 45 At Cullen Blvd.:** Rehabilitate pump station and construct new detention pond.
- **0912-00-605 Various locations district-wide:** Install new ITS equipment at various locations.
- **0912-00-606 Various locations district-wide:** Replace CCTV equipment with new upgraded equipment.
- **0912-00-609 Various locations district-wide:** Install new ITS equipment at various locations.
- **0912-00-611 Various locations district-wide:** Upgrade dynamic message sign boards.
- **0912-00-655 Various locations district-wide:** Provide ITS support.
- **0912-00-656 Various locations district-wide:** Replace CCTV equipment with new upgraded equipment.
- **0912-00-657 Various locations district-wide:** Provide ITS support.
- **0912-00-658 Various locations district-wide:** Upgrade dynamic message sign boards.
- **0912-00-659 Various locations district-wide:** Upgrade communications system.
- **1685-05-105 SH 6 At FM 529:** Intersection Improvements.
- **3256-02-110 SL 8 At IH 69 North:** Rehabilitate existing pump station and upgrade the pump controls and trash collection system
- **No CSJ Yet SH 6 From IH 10 W to Clay Road:** Raise roadway to eliminate flooding from Addicks Reservoir.
- **No CSJ Yet SH 6 From FM 1093 (Westheimer Road) to Piping Rock Lane:** The project includes a 5- to 6-foot wide sidewalks NB and a 10ft shared use path SB, high visibility crossing striping, ADA ramps, pavement markings, median refuge and signage as well as other associated intersection improvements.
- **No CSJ Yet IH 610 N From IH 45 N to IH 69 N:** Safety, operational, and mobility improvements to IH 610 N mainlanes and frontage roads, based on results of IH 610 North Feasibility Study
- **No CSJ Yet SH 99 From IH 10 W to Mercantile Pkwy across SH 99 to Mason Road:** The project includes side path, high visibility crossing striping, ADA ramps, pavement markings, and signage as well as other associated intersection improvements. Construct a pedestrian/bicycle underpass.
- **No CSJ Yet SL 8 From Woodforest Blvd to Wallisville Road (SL 8 NB) and from Wallisville Road to Dalton Oaks Drive (SL 8 SB):** The project includes a 5- to 6-foot-wide sidewalks, high visibility crossing striping, ADA ramps, pavement markings, and signage as well as other associated intersection improvements. The project also includes a pedestrian bridge.
- **No CSJ Yet SH 35 From DIXIE DR to BS 35 S (N GORDON ST):** Conduct a mobility study to identify mobility and safety improvements on SH 35. Previously MPOIDs 309, 310, 18717, and 18718
- **No CSJ Yet SH 6 From Westheimer (FM 1093) to IH 10 W:** This project proposes safety and operational improvements.
- **No CSJ Yet SH 99 From Colonial Pkwy to IH 10 W:** The project includes a 10-foot wide sidepath, high visibility crossing striping, ADA ramps, pavement markings, and signage as well as other associated intersection improvements.
- **No CSJ Yet IH 10 W From Mason Road to Mason Creek:** The project includes a 10-foot wide sidepath, high visibility crossing striping, ADA ramps, pavement markings, and signage as well as other associated intersection improvements. The project also includes an underpass at IH 10 W.
- **No CSJ Yet FM 521 From West Airport Blvd. to South SL 8L:** The project includes a 5- to 6-foot-wide sidewalks, high visibility crossing striping, ADA ramps, pavement markings, bus stop pads, and signage as well as other associated intersection improvements.



The City of Houston is committed to working with TxDOT and area stakeholders on projects that meet our shared objectives.
